

2018 AGPT application and selection process

Step 1: Apply online

Apply online during the application period **10:00am AEST 10 April 2017 – 10:00 am AEST 8 May 2017** at your chosen fellowship college/s website:

→ RACGP: www.racgp.org.au

→ ACRRM: www.acrrm.org.au



In your application, nominate your chosen training pathway (general and/or rural pathway) and up to four training region preferences.

Step 2: Pay college application fee and participate in stage 1 assessment

RACGP

Application fee: \$725

No. training places: 90% of training places nationally

Stage 1 assessment - 22 July:

- Candidate Assessment and Applied Knowledge Test (CAAKT) computer assessment

ACRRM

Application fee: \$700

No. training places: 10% of training places nationally

Stage 1 assessment - Completed by 19 July:

- ACRRM suitability assessment document review
- Referee checks



If your stage 1 assessment score is above the college cut-off you may progress to stage 2 assessments.



If your stage 1 assessment score falls below the college cut-off your selection journey ends here.

Step 3: Participate in stage 2 assessment with RTO

RACGP

Stage 2 assessment - 12-27 August:

- Multiple Mini Interviews (MMIs) with RTO.
- NSW/ACT applicants rank training subregion preferences.

ACRRM

Stage 2 assessment - 5-25 August:

- Interview with ACRRM selection team and RTO
- NSW/ACT applicants rank training subregion preferences.



NSW/ACT training offers and subregion allocation made on basis of score up to the number of places available.



You may be waitlisted to see if places become available. Otherwise you will enter second round.*

2-4 Aug	Applicants who score above the minimum score cut off are notified of Multiple Mini Interviews (MMI) date/time. NSW/ACT training region shortlisted applicants sent subregion preference survey.
12-27 Aug	RTO MMIs
31 Aug – 7 Sep	Successful applicants sent training offers
8-19 Sep	Applicants unsuccessful in being made a training offer are invited to participate in second round for any remaining training places.*
21 Sep	Applicants notified of Multiple Mini Interviews (MMI) date/time
30 Sep – 1 Oct	RTO second round MMIs
2-6 Oct	Successful second round applicants sent training offers
